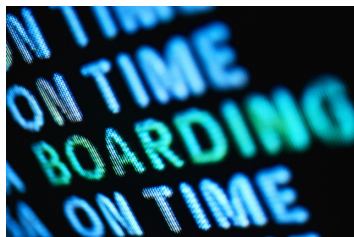
### SINGING AIRPORT ATTENDANTS
